- Qualifications:** Applicants will have a B.A. Major, Diploma or Honours degree in Art History or equivalent, and be enrolled in or entering a graduate program in Art History or Critical and Curatorial Studies.
- Duties:** Attend weekly lectures, may conduct weekly seminars or discussion groups, assist with marking as well as with course materials and assignments for students enrolled in the course.
- Hours of work:** A full Teaching Assistantship involves an average of twelve (12) hours per week for the Winter Session (September 1 to April 30), for a total of 384 hours. The salary for a partial Teaching Assistantship shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis. Please see www.students.ubc.ca under Courses for scheduled lecture and tutorial times. A precise schedule of duties and hour allocation will be arranged with the course instructor.
